Outside of work and politics, Iain is a lifelong lover of music, spent years coaching and managing his children's hockey and soccer teams, and has served on non-profit boards. These experiences reinforced—in a very personal way—the importance of strong communities and neighbours who look out for one another.

Living in British Columbia and raising a family here keeps Iain grounded. It reminds him that good government isn't just about policy—it's about people, opportunity, and communities where families can truly thrive.

A CAREER BUILT ON RESULTS

Iain has spent his career at the intersection of business, government, and community focused on solving real problems and delivering outcomes people can rely on. He did not come to leadership through ideology or slogans, but through accountability, evidence, and results.

He served as a two-term MLA and cabinet minister in three key economic portfolios, working to modernize trade, streamline regulation, support small businesses, improve employment standards, and diversify international markets. In every role, his approach was collaborative, pragmatic, and fiscally responsible.

As President and CEO of the Greater Vancouver Board of Trade, Iain revitalized Western Canada's leading business advocacy organization, strengthening its policy voice and its ability to bring business, labour, and government together around shared priorities.

In the private sector, as President and CEO, and later Vice Chair, of Maximizer CRM, Iain led a multi-year renewal that strengthened competitiveness, rebuilt leadership capacity, and modernized operations.
